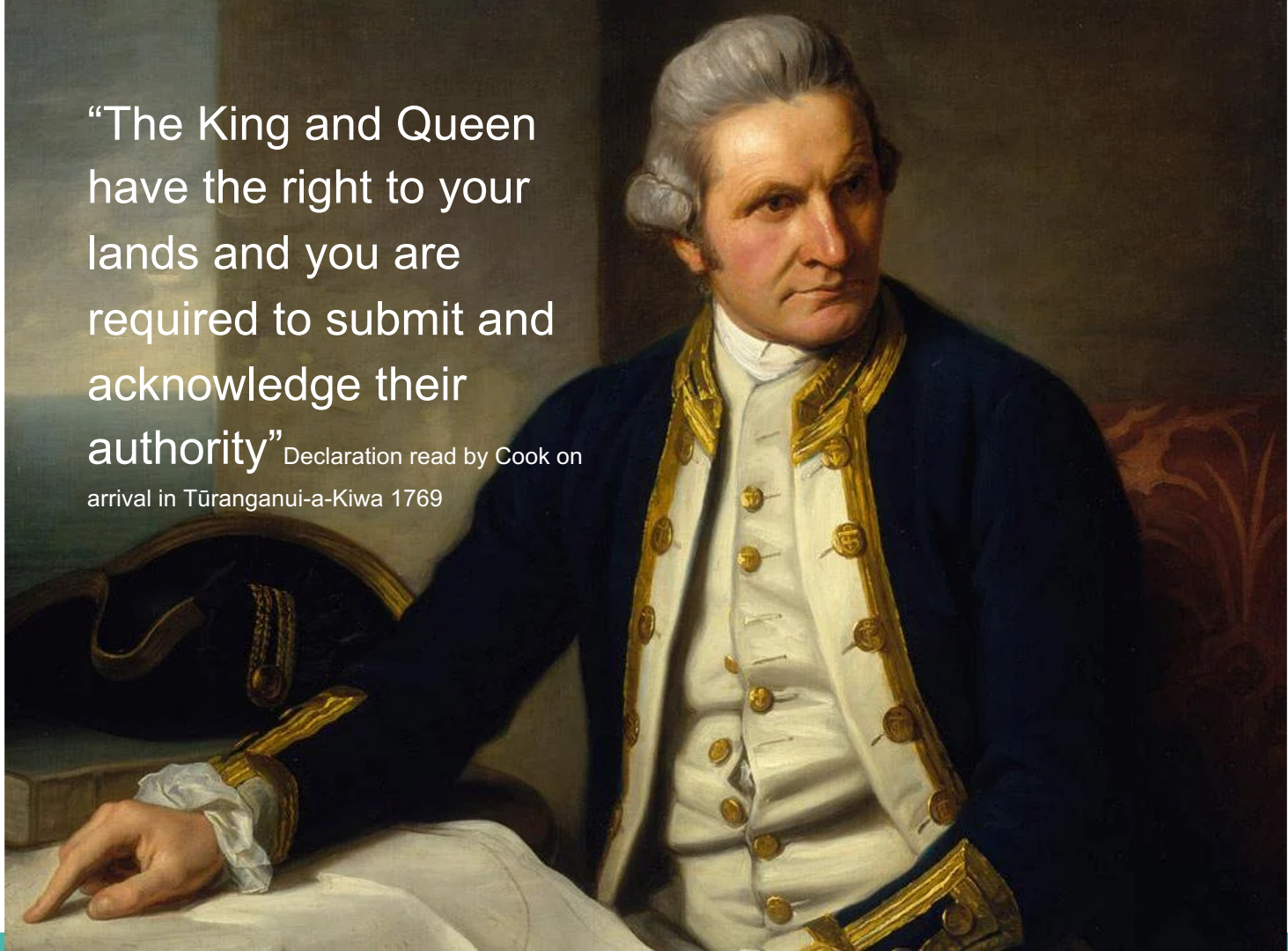
# The Doctrine of Discovery - 1498

Legal and religious concept to justify colonial **conquest** and **dispossession** of indigenous people.

It advanced the idea that **European** peoples, culture, **knowledge** and religion were **superior** to all others.

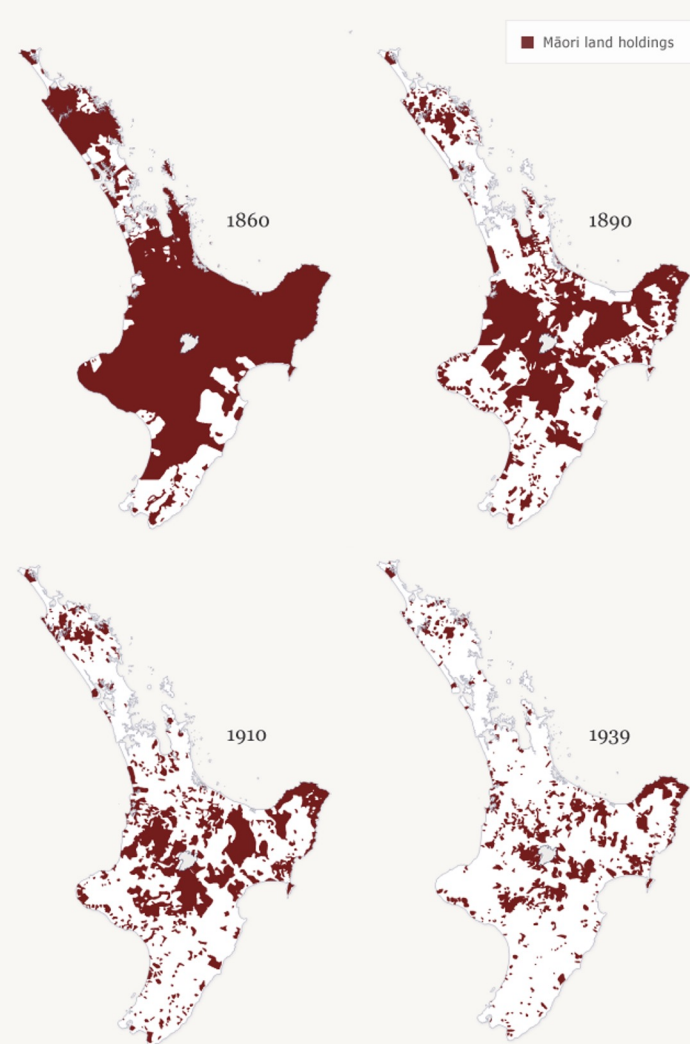


“The King and Queen
